5. <u>Susan Lonie</u> presented the **President's report**

6. Trisha Blanks presented the Secretary's report

8. Business Arising from Committee Meeting 25th October 2021:

<u>Trevor Greenfield</u> discussed two new bee training courses being considered for next year; the implications and costs. A basic beekeeping skill class for hobbyist beekeepers and an advanced beekeeping course that results in a certificate 3.

8. Guest Topic: - Michael Stedman from PIRSA spoke about fire safety and basic fire safety requirements. Smokers can be used during fire danger season with the intent you light the fuel <u>inside</u> the smoker. It is recommended to look at your bees on total fire ban days only in emergency cases. It is also recommended to carry a fire extinguisher out in country settings; make sure it is maintained and checked regularly to ensure insurance cover. Michael suggested more water around hives; bees drink up to 4 litres of water on 40 degree days.

9. Strictly Beekeeping:

Rossi and Len spoke about Honey harvesting

- Have the bees got enough honey for themselves to last until they have honey coming in again?
- Rossi suggested clearer boards when harvesting to remove bees from frames efficiently.
- To prevent robbing reduce entrances.
- Swarming occurs around space in the brood box. The queen needs room to lay in order to prevent swarming.
