1. <u>Strictly Beekeeping – Bob Beer</u>

First inspection of hives coming out of winter and into spring

An increase in daylight hours, increase temperatures and increase in pollen and nectar resources motivate queen to increase laying.

Is the hive 'Queen' right?

Are there:

Eggs? Sealed and unsealed brood? Sealed and unsealed honey? Is it freshly capped off, is it uncapped? How much is left over from autumn 2021? How much pollen is available?

Disease management

Start observing what is normal and healthy. Information and plenty of images about honey bee pests and diseases are available on BeeAware

When do I put on honey supers? Not before the end of September.

Providing room for the queen to lay eggs

Place three new frames with comb or sheets of foundation into the brood box. This should be done one at a time in readiness for September. One frame every ten days. This also does not create unnecessary space in the brood box whilst the temperatures are still cooler.

What frame do I remove to make room for my new frame? Remove frame 1 and frame 10.

<u>How do I re Queen my hive</u> Requeen by using a frame from another hive that has some queen cells on it and without any bees.

How do you euthanise a Queen? Place her in a container and into the freezer. This euthanises the queen by causing her to fall asleep.

I want to split my hive, when should I do this?

End of Spring Early summer.
